

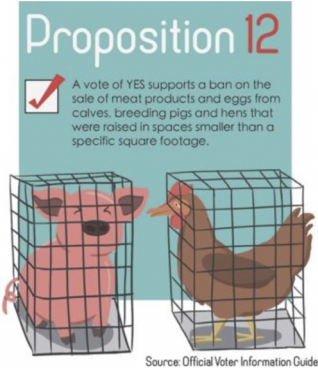

**Tell Congress to Protect Anti-Cruelty Laws
for Farmed Animals**



Once again, hard-won humane laws like California's Proposition 12 are at risk. The Ending Agricultural Trade Suppression (EATS) Act, "Save Our Bacon" Act, and similar proposals in Congress threaten to **wipe out** existing state laws requiring welfare standards for animals raised for meat and dairy and prohibit states from implementing future ethical sales regulations. Express your opposition to these bills, which are a direct attempt to eviscerate citizen power and commandeer states' rights to protect animals and public health.

Good News for Animals

Gestation Crate Restriction in Ohio



Ohio has become the 11th US state to restrict the use of gestation crates for breeding sows, closing a 15-year chapter of campaigning and negotiation between animal advocates and the state's powerful agribusiness sector. The new rules curb the extreme confinement of gestating pigs in metal cages so small they cannot turn around or fully stretch their limbs. However, farrowing cages, which are used for mother pigs after having given birth, have not yet been banned.
